The return of the Formula 1 Heineken Dutch Grand Prix to Zandvoort, after 36 years of absence, was a huge success. Together with all parties involved, history was written last two editions. Each day more than a hundred thousand fans, mostly dressed in orange, experienced a unique F1 race and entertainment programme at Circuit Zandvoort. An estimated 70 million fans worldwide watched the race weekend at Zandvoort via television. The Netherlands, and Zandvoort in particular, have been put on the map. A showcase of Dutch entrepreneurship, organisational skills, entertainment and sports fans.

ABOUT ZANDVOORT

Zandvoort, a quaint seaside town in the Netherlands, boasts approximately 17,000 residents and is conveniently located within a half-hour drive from the country's capital, Amsterdam. It is a favoured destination for both domestic and international tourists alike. Renowned for its expansive 9-kilometer beach adorned with over 35 stylish beach pavilions, Zandvoort attracts five-million-day visitors and accommodates one million overnight stays annually, solidifying its status as the premier seaside resort in the Netherlands.

Beyond its picturesque beaches and natural allure, Zandvoort is also distinguished by its historic racetrack, established in 1948. Hosting a legacy of 36 Formula 1 races and renowned drivers, Circuit Zandvoort remains a focal point for motorsport enthusiasts year-round. The town's identity is intimately intertwined with racing culture, warmly welcoming fans from across the globe.

The circuit

In 2021 Circuit Zandvoort underwent major renovations, both on and off the track. With new asphalt, banked corners, a modified pit lane and many more changes, the circuit got its required Grade 1 license to hold a F1 race in Zandvoort. A large number of permanent and temporary modifications have also been made off the racetrack. To provide safe and comfortable access for all fans, three entrances and two additional tunnels have been constructed. In addition, nearly 85,000 temporary seats have been built especially for the event.


In order to prepare yourself and to get into the mood, you can already take a look at the map of the circuit.



This year, the circuit experienced a significant transformation for the 2024 Formula 1 race.

The pit lane has been extended, and the number of pit boxes has been increased. These changes were necessary to meet FIA quality standards, but also to create a new dynamic for the circuit, even outside the race weekend.

Water Management Mastery

The Netherlands excels in water management, given that a significant portion of the country lies below sea level. The Delta Works and the Afsluitdijk are impressive feats of engineering that protect the land from flooding. In addition to these, we also rely on an extensive system of dikes and dunes. For example, Circuit Zandvoort sits below sea level (NAP). Without our sophisticated water management systems, the circuit and many other areas would be submerged.

Tulip Mania

The Netherlands is renowned worldwide for its tulips. Each year, millions of tulip bulbs are exported, and the Keukenhof in Lisse is one of the largest flower gardens in the world, where you can admire a spectacular display of blooms in spring.

Mobility

For your own personal transport, we strongly suggest you use the most sustainable options as set out in chapter 3 of this event book. When you are delivering materials or have materials delivered, we kindly request you to keep the following things in mind:

- Plan carefully, making sure that the number of rides is reduced to the absolute minimum.
- If possible, make use of electric vehicles (please note that recharging options are not available at the circuit).

Energy

We have reduced 95% of our CO2 footprint since the start in 2021. We have extended our grid power supply, and all generators are using HVO 100 fuel. Please be aware of your actions regarding energy use. Do you require power? Please contact the production office for the best option.

Nature

Preserving nature and reducing our waste is vital. We not only sort all our waste after collection, but we also strive to recovering 75% of our single use plastic cups for recycling. Please make sure you don't litter. Our food is reused by the local food bank after collection on Sunday evening. This is organized centrally. Also be cautious when handling materials. Don't spill materials in or around the venue.

Social Impact

The F1 Heineken Dutch Grand Prix is an event for everyone. For that reason, we have an extra care court, located at the Main Straight Grandstand and numerous other facilities. We also provide temporary wheelchairs at Gate 2 for people in need.

As previously mentioned, we have reduced our CO² emissions by 94.5% since 2021, with 98% of our visitors attending the event in a sustainable manner. The Dutch Grand Prix is renowned for its sustainable mobility plan. We encourage all visitors, staff, and crew to travel sustainably to Zandvoort. Additionally, the Formula 1 Heineken Dutch Grand Prix is the only Grand Prix in the world with a train station within walking distance of the circuit.

Road closures

During the event days the roads to Zandvoort are closed to anyone without a FOM car pass. The reasoning behind this is to avoid traffic and therefore delays. Zandvoort is familiar with traffic delays during regular summer days. This is also expected during the event days. Please keep this in mind and travel early to avoid traffic.

OPTIONS OF TRANSPORTATION

Below you can find the various options, ranking from most sustainable to the least sustainable. .

- Bike
- Public Transport
- Car Parking

Bike

Media can enter the circuit with a scooter or bike via gate 2. Please park your vehicle at the media parking facility next to the media centre entrance (downstairs). It is not allowed to cycle or ride over the circuit other than from and to the entrance at gate 2. To enter the circuit, you need to collect an official accreditation sticker and show your media accreditation at the gate. You can collect a vehicle-sticker at the MAC.

NOTE: in the Netherlands an electric step is forbidden on the public roads. The police could give a fine of €410,-

Public transport

Public Bus Transport

The bus is one of the best options for everyone staying or living in the Amsterdam region (incl. Amstelveen, Uithoorn, Aalsmeer) and Schiphol/Hoofddorp. This is also a direct and comfortable transport option from Amsterdam Zuidoost. Visitors from outside these regions mainly choose other transport options, which means that you can travel to the circuit by bus comfortably and with less pressure.

Not only can you travel by bus throughout the region of Amsterdam, Meerlanden and Haarlem-IJmond, but bus lines 300 and 356 run directly from Haarlem Station to the main entrance of the circuit. Within 14 minutes you can be at Gate 1 from Haarlem Station. Connexxion runs between 10 and 12 times an hour on average, so you never have to wait long for the next bus. Bus lines 300 and 356 run directly to Zandvoort and back towards Haarlem train station during inflow (08:00–12:00) and outflow (after F1 practice, qualification and race), so there is no need to transfer between buses. The buses also run directly from Schiphol/Hoofddorp.

Train

The Dutch Grand Prix is the only Grand Prix in the world with a train station within walking distance of the circuit. Specially for the event, a large number of extra trains run during the Dutch Grand Prix. From the NS-station Zandvoort aan Zee it is less than 15 minutes walk to the entrance of the circuit. Extra trains run between Amsterdam Central Station and Zandvoort Station, so you never have to wait long for the next train. You can travel to Zandvoort with your debit card, OV chip-card or buy a ticket online in advance.

MEDIA HOTEL

For media, the Van der Valk Schiphol Airport is appointed as official Media Hotel. A media shuttle service will be provided from the hotel if you have reserved a room.

MEDIA PARKING AT P-ZUID & SHUTTLE

For media, there is parking lot situated at P-De Zuid. There are parking spots available for accredited media. Media should follow the following signage and routes to Zandvoort. The most convenient way to drive is by taking A9 to Alkmaar. Then take the N205 to Zandvoort which guides you through Haarlem. Eventually the signage below will show up on the roads.



Shuttle services


From the Media Parking there will be shuttles to Zandvoort circuit according to the following timetable (10-20 minute drive) the buses will constantly pendel back and forth from the P-De Zuid (Brederodestraat) to the circuit at gate 2 (in front of the NH-Hotel). The bus stops will be marked with signs.




Busstop sign

MEDIA ACCREDITATION CENTRE (MAC)

The Circuit Zandvoort can only be entered with special FIA and FOM passes.

The Media Accreditation Centre (MAC) is situated at Hotel NH Zandvoort. Located directly across the circuit, with limited car park availability for pick-up.

Note: Please be advised to come by public transport to pick up your accreditation. The NH hotel is in walking distance of the circuit.


Those guests who need to pick up their parking pass at the MAC, will be allowed through at the check point at the Zandvoortselaan.

- There will be a list at the check point.
- Through an ID check and invitation/confirmation letter from the FOM you will be able to drive through.
- At the NH parking are limited parking spaces available from Wednesday August 21 till Saturday August 24, where you can park for 15 minutes to pick up accreditation and/or the MOPED/parking pass.

The accreditation centre is situated in meeting room 2. There will be direction signs when entering the hotel.



By car

Follow the route to the circuit, you can park at the private parking lot at Hotel NH Zandvoort. On Wednesday, you can reach Zandvoort and the MAC without check points or roadblocks. From Thursday on, you can pass the check points coming into Zandvoort by showing your ID and official FIA/FOM accreditation confirmation letter. Please note, there is very limited parking space at the MAC. Parking at the NH Zandvoort Hotel is only allowed to collect your accreditation.

Train: from Schiphol Airport, a train leaves for Zandvoort aan Zee every 30 minutes. Cab: the ride takes 35 minutes.

By train

From Zandvoort aan Zee station: take bus 84 to the Circuit. From Zandvoort aan Zee station it is a 12-minute walk to the hotel.

The Media Centre is located on the 1st floor of the Pit Building.

Entrance to the circuit

When arriving at the entrance of the circuit at gate 2, please use the lane indicating CREW. (see image below). You will be redirected to this lane at all times. During opening hours of the Media Centre, a shuttle service is running from gate 2 to the Media Centre, starting at the Shell station. (see appendix B). Media coming with bike or scooter, need to collect a MOPED-sticker at the MAC to enter via gate 2.



Lanes at the entrance, media must enter via crew lane.

EVACUATION

- Carefully listen to your radio and follow given instruction
- Proceed to the indicated muster point
- Do NOT take initiative but follow the given instructions
- Stay on the indicated muster point and await further information.

Hightlights

Dutch GP likes to do things differently. We want to create memorable moments that draw the attention of those on-site, but also the fan at home. We have pinpointed a few activities across the weekend that truly showcase what the Dutch Grand Prix is all about.

A festival atmosphere on Super Friday, targeting the new fan with a strong entertainment line-up throughout a spectacular Opening & Closing show on the MainStage. Multiple Fan activations on Saturday and Sunday where fans are engaged to become part of the content. New, surprising elements to a traditionally already packed pre-race show. And of course thousands and thousands making their way to the track with the most common way of transport in the Netherlands; bicycles!

An event Like No Other - one that should be on the bucket list of every F1 fan.

Outside the event - fan travel

Imagine this: 98% of fans traveling to a Grand Prix event in a sustainable way, of which:

- 50% Public Transport
- 30% Bicycle (2023 data)

Unique content:

- Orange fan parade cycling towards the circuit through the dunes
- Endless views of bicycle storages on the boulevard (> 40.000).

Iconic Flag Action

Largest Flag Action in Dutch Sports History at the Formula 1 Heineken Dutch Grand Prix.

The 2023 Pre-Race Show featuring André Rieu, combined with the flag show on the main straight, received global recognition. This year, the iconic flag action will be extended to the entire circuit. Together with 90,000 fans and accordionist Hans Kap, Tino Martin will perform an Amsterdam Medley, turning the entire circuit red, white, and blue. It will be the largest flag action in Dutch sports history.

Drivers parade

Because the Dutch Grand Prix is like no other, we have decided to change our approach in the drivers parade. We are going to transform the Driver Parade into a proper Parade, as we know it from Carnival. Fans will be surprised by a real Parade of various vehicles. The regular Driver Parade truck will be replaced by a float fully decorated with flowers, hosting the drivers. It will be accompanied by a replica F1 car made of flowers, bikes representing the nationality of all the drivers and cargo bikes with additional decoration. 


