## **Technical Delegate's Report**

After the qualifying session the energy store (ES) of car number 22, driver Jenson Button, was replaced for a new one which is one of the five new energy stores (ES) allowed for the 2016 Championship season and this is in conformity with Article 23.4a of the 2016 Formula One Sporting Regulations.

The energy store (ES) has been replaced with the approval of the FIA technical delegate following a written request from the team concerned, this being in accordance with Article 34.2 of the 2016 Formula One Sporting Regulations.
