MEDIA CENTRE FACILITIES

The Media Accreditation Centre is at the West Gate Entrance of Yas Marina Circuit and the Media Centre for the FORMULA 1 ETIHAD AIRWAYS ABU DHABI GRAND PRIX 2019 is located in the Paddock, opposite Race Control. The journalists' and the photographers' work rooms are on the first floor of the Media Centre.

IT CHARGES

Standard line set-up charges are FREE.

ISDN LINES

These are available only by pre-order; the set-up cost is as for a standard line.

INTERNET

Internet access is available Free of Charge.

TELECOMS CENTRE

The first floor has a Telecoms Centre. Internet connection is also available at no cost in the Telecoms Centre. However, access is limited to 30 minutes per user at any one time. IT support staff will be on hand.

LOCKERS

Free lockers are available on the first floor of the Media Centre. Each locker has its own key in for privacy.

CATERING IN THE MEDIA CENTRE

RACE REVIEW

LEWIS HAMILTON SHINES TO WIN AT YAS MARINA CIRCUIT

Lewis Hamilton signed off 2018 with a comfortable victory at the Abu Dhabi Grand Prix, his 11th of the season.

The Briton held the lead from pole into Turn 1 and benefitted from being the only front-runner to pit under a Virtual Safety Car to hold a decent advantage as the rest couldn't close up on their fresher tyres.

It was an eventful start which saw Max Verstappen slip down the field to 10th and Charles Leclerc move ahead of Daniel Ricciardo on the second back straight to Turn 11 into fifth.

Just behind, contact between Nico Hulkenberg and Romain Grosjean punted the German's Renault into a barrel roll, resting upside down against the barrier.

A Safety Car was immediately called to extract Hulkenberg.

At the restart, Verstappen set about making up for a slow launch passing Esteban Ocon into the Turn 7 hairpin.

Struggling for power on the exit, however, both Force Indias would pull ahead before the Dutchman remade the positions within a lap, including an aggressive move on the Frenchman again at Turn 7, with emotions still raw between the pair after colliding in Brazil.

The VSC would be called soon after as Kimi Raikkonen ground to a halt on the pit straight in his final race for Ferrari following an engine shutdown.

Hamilton would take advantage to stop for the Supersoft tyre, dropping down to fifth, but lost a lot less time in comparison to those ahead who all stopped later.

The race settled with Valtteri Bottas leading from Sebastian Vettel and the two Red Bulls following, as Leclerc dropped down the order having also pitted with Hamilton under the VSC.

Soon they would pit, however, along with Verstappen and trailed Hamilton by 11 seconds.

An unexpected rain shower passed over the circuit without causing any problem but Ricciardo would run long on his first stint to have fresher tyres for the final 20 laps.

Bottas' race would then fade with a lock-up at Turn 5 allowing Vettel to make a move into Turn 11 for second, Verstappen and Ricciardo also passed Finn dropping him to fifth as he then stopped for a second time to fall out of contention.

The question in the closing laps would be if Ricciardo could move ahead of his teammate for a final Red Bull podium but a serious challenge never materialized.

At the front, Hamilton was unchallenged as he took the chequered flag by 2.5 seconds from Vettel to end the season on a high.

Vettel followed in second with Verstappen to completing the top three.

In his final race, Fernando Alonso would try to hunt down Kevin Magnussen for the final point in the closing laps but would instead pick up 15 seconds worth of penalties for cutting the track as the Spaniard finished 11th.

Pierre Gasly, Esteban Ocon and Marcus Ericsson would join Kimi Raikkonen in retiring, after all suffered from engine issues.

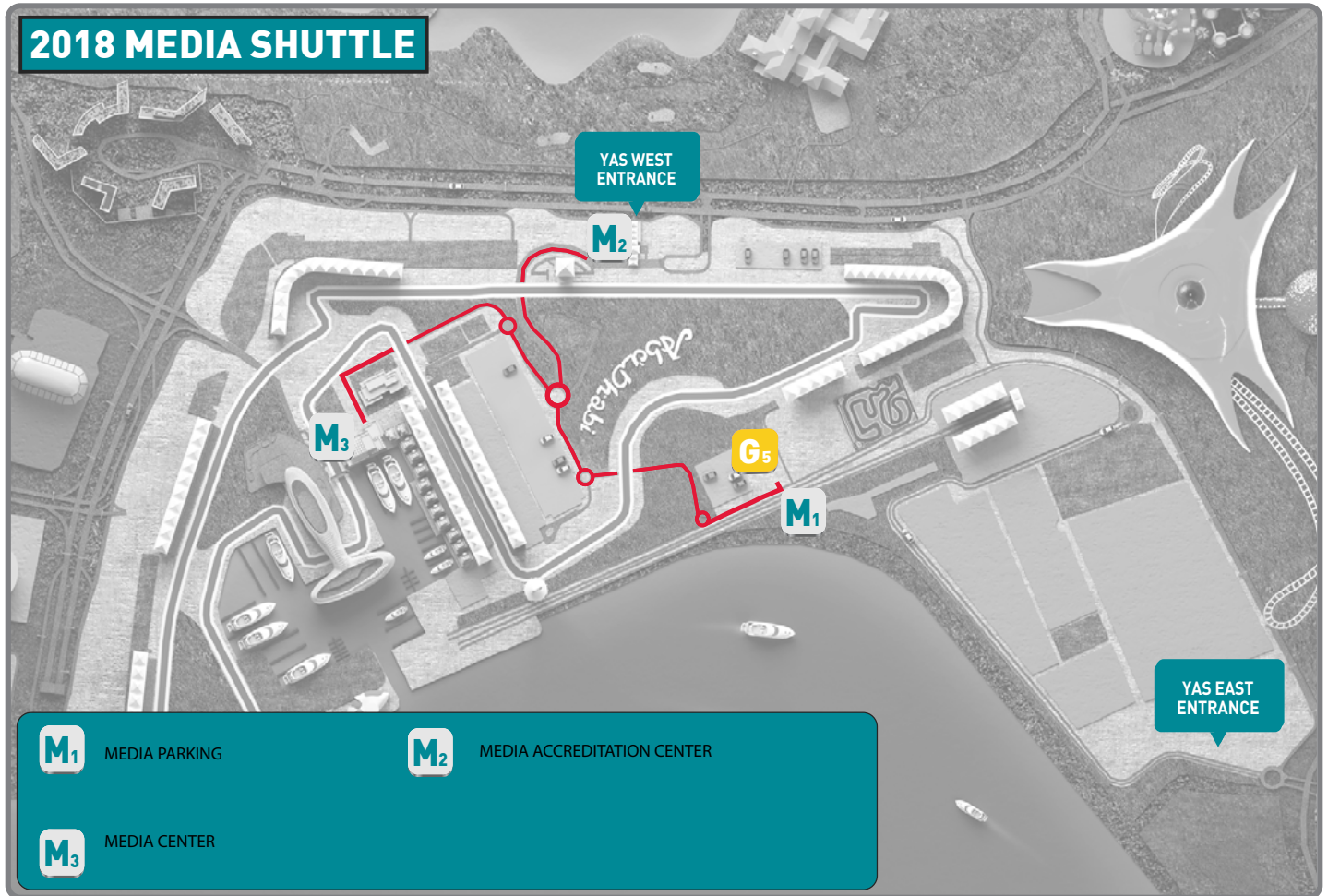

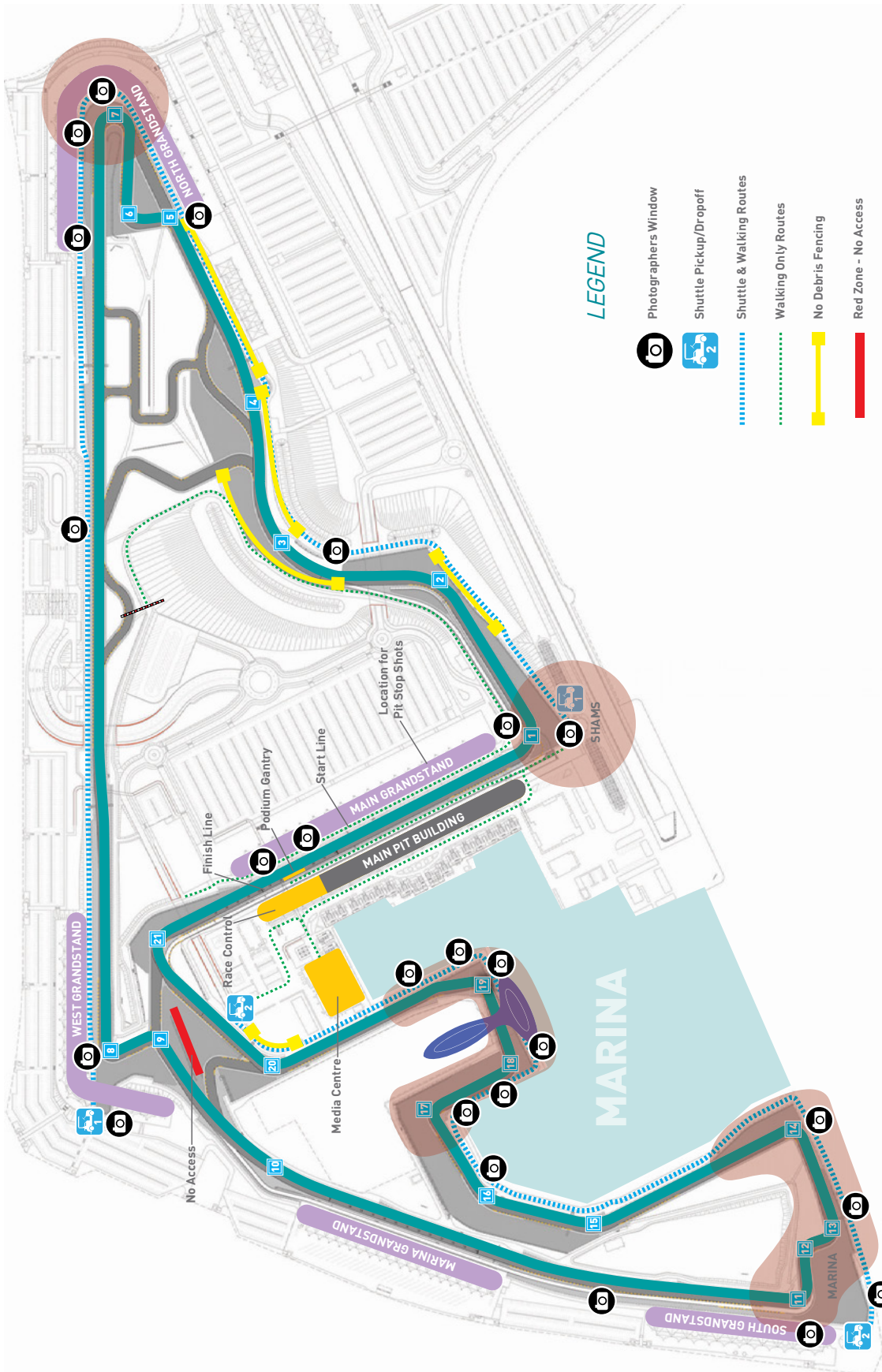
