Andrew Papadopoulos attained his Marketing and Business Management qualifications whilst living in London in the early 1970s.

He spent several years employed within the UK marketing industry before returning to Sydney, where he completed his Economics Degree at Macquarie University.

In 1985, Andrew saw a niche opportunity to develop a business that focussed on the repair, supply and recycling of pallets to Australian manufacturing industries. Kiss Pallets (Keep It Simple Systems Pty Ltd) is now in its 28th year of operation.

Andrew is a Chairman and President of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport (CAMS). He is also a Board Member of the CAMS Foundation, Board Member for Rally Australia, and Board Member for Australian Institute for Motor Sport Safety Ltd (AIMSS) and is a Life Member of the Alfa Romeo Owners Club of Australia.

Andrew has significantly contributed to the development of the Alfa Romeo driver safety program and in bringing these learning's to CAMS; he has been instrumental in the development of Ignition, the driver safety education program for 12 to 18 years olds.

Andrew has been involved in motor sport for over 35 years as a competitor in Classic Rallying and today competes on the circuit in his Alfa sports sedan.
