Brian is the Chief Executive of the New Zealand Automobile Association (NZAA), a role he has held since 1990.

Brian holds Board Directorship for a number of subsidiary commercial companies, including AA Insurance Limited and AA Batteries Limited. He is the Chairman on the Board of AA Life Limited and he is a Director of MARAC Insurance Limited.

Since 2009, in addition to his roles mentioned, Brian has held the position of Deputy President for FIA Automobile, Mobility and Tourism.
