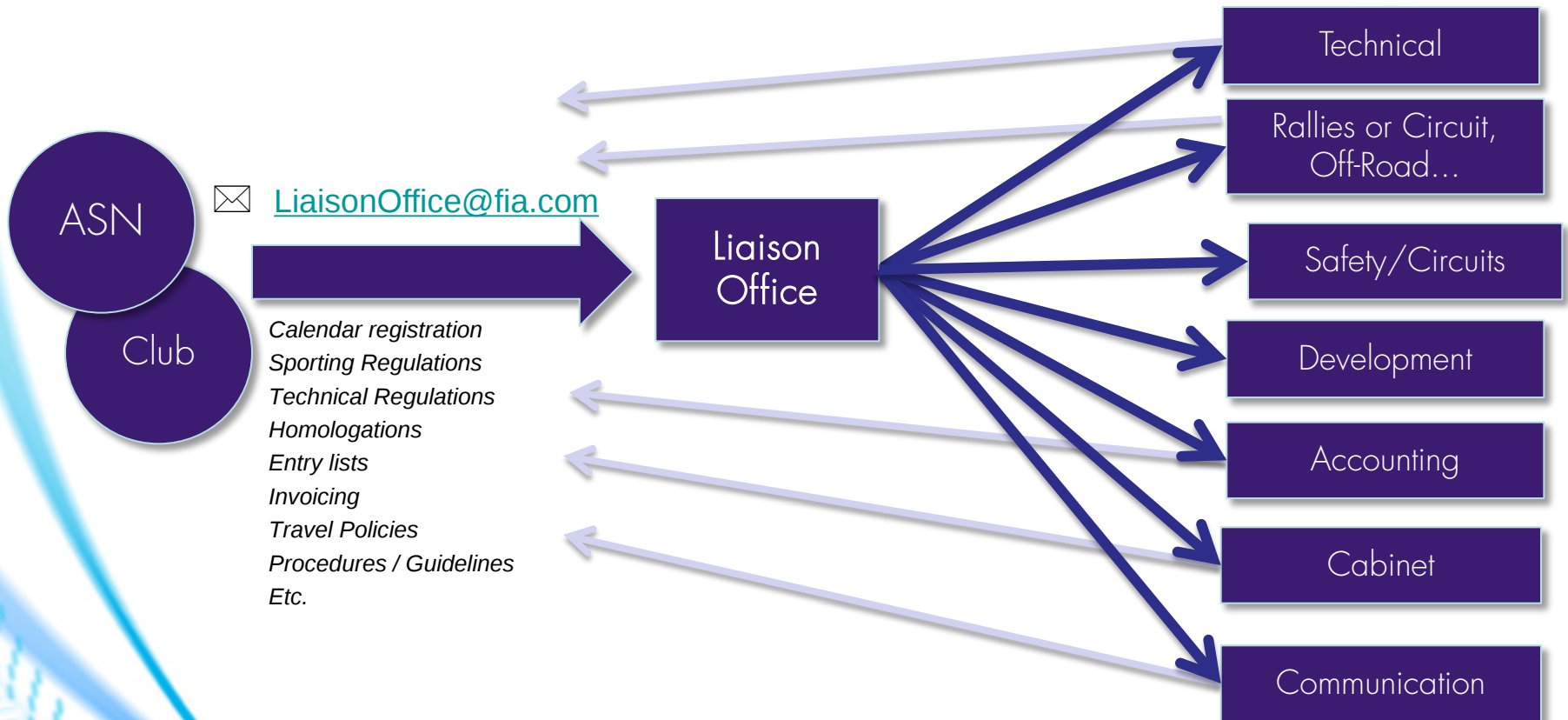

☞ GLOBAL TRAINING PROGRAMME

- Unique platform of training for ASNs organised in different modules and managed by the FIA sport in collaboration with various partners.
- Appointment of approved trainers for delivering trainings sessions (e.g. an FIA appointed expert or an FIA Institute-approved Regional Training Provider)
- E-learning platform to be trained easily and in an affordable way.

FIA NETWORKS PLATFORM :

A new portal for ASNs to communicate, provide services, key information and training.
