Single Seater Commission President

Gerhard Berger is the President of the Single Seater Commission of the FIA since 2011.

Prior to being involved with the FIA, Gerard Berger has been the director of BMW Motorsport between 1998 and 2003 and he participated to the arrival of the Scuderia Toro Rosso by being a shareholder from 2000 to 2008.

A veteran Formula One driver who officially retired in 1997, Berger has been notably associated with Benetton Formula. He has won ten Grand Prix throughout his F1 career, and was ranked third overall after the 1988 and 1994 seasons.

Prior to joining F1 in 1984 and for several years from this date, Berger was also an episodic European Touring Car Championship competitor, also winning the 1985 24h de Spa Francorchamps endurance race.
