A barrister in practice at the Bar of England and Wales, Graham Stoker is a recognised legal expert in Sports Law. A former UK national race steward, Stoker has held various senior positions within UK motorsport, including Chairman of the Judicial Committee of the RAC Motor Sports Association, Chairman of the MSA National Court, Chairman of the United Kingdom Motor Sports Council and joint Chairman of the MSA.

He joined the FIA International Court of Appeal in 2001, hearing a range of motor sport cases, and acting as a President of the Court, and took a leading role in the restructuring of the rules of the Court in 2004. Currently Deputy President for Sport, he assists the President in chairing the World Motor Sport Council, and is a member of the Senate and a Trustee of the FIA Foundation.
