

Hermann Tomczyk



Honorary President of the DMSB

Hermann Tomczyk was born in Mais/St. Georgen near Traunstein in 1950. He graduated in business administration and joined ADAC in 1979. In 1997, he was elected ADAC Motor Sport President and became Chairman of the ADAC Sport Subcommittee. Moreover, he was appointed Chairman of the Board of Trustees of the ADAC Stiftung Sport (ADAC sport foundation) in 1998. His career further includes the position of Vice President of the German Motor Sport Federation (DMSB) between 1997 and 2006, whose President he was between 2006 and 2008.

Since 2009, he has been Honorary President of the DMSB. During that time (1997-2009), Tomczyk also was a member of the FIA World Motor Sport Council, an office he resumed in 2013, and between 2005 and 2009, he was Vice President of the FIA.

In 1992, Tomczyk was awarded the Ewald Kroth medal in gold with crest and in 2003 the honorary medal from the Ministry of Justice of Bavaria.
