GP3 Series driver

Jann is racing in the GP3 Series for Arden Motorsport since 2014 and integrates an intensive driver development programme with Infiniti Red Bull Racing. He also competed in the Sebring 12 Hours in the Nissan-powered Pickett Racing LMP2 car and with OAK Racing in the Le Mans 24 Hours where he finished 9th.

Jann raced in the FIA Formula 3 European Championship and the British F3 International Series in 2013. He finished twice on the podium. In the meantime, He participated for the first time to Le Mans 24 Hours and the Spa 24 Hours in the No. 32 Nissan GT-R Nismo GT3 where he scored a Pro-Am podium.

During 2012, Jann ran the British GT Championship in the RJN Motorsport Nissan GT-R Nismo GT3 and took the first big win at Brands Hatch. He finished on the podium at Dubai 24 Hours in “All-Gamer” Nissan 370Z. For his undeniable talent, he also received several awards like EVO magazine’s Emerging Talent award or Rising Star award status by the British Racing Driver’s Club.

Jann started his young career in 2011 when he participated in the GT Academy sponsored by Nissan and Sony. He beat 90,000 other entrants through racing on the *Gran Turismo* series of PlayStation driving games to earn the chance to become a professional racing driver. After an intensive Race Camp, Jann has been declared Champion of the Academy and became a professional driver with Nissan.

Jann followed an atypical pathway to reach this level of competition. Described by a lot as “blessed with star quality without the swagger, abundant aptitude without the attitude, and the kind of blistering pace that makes you want to weep” (EVO Magazine), his remarkable skills and his perfect attitude opened the doors of the racing world.

During the Sport Conference through “Attracting young people into our sport” subject, Jann will share his experience and will give some keys to reach the highest level of competition.
