Medical Chairman, DMSB

Dr. Michael Scholz is the Medical Chairman of the German Motor Sport Federation (DMSB), a member of the FIA Medical Commission and the appointed Chief Medical Officer of the German Grand Prix since 2010.

He has been involved in sports medicine, diagnostics and development in competitive sport since the early nineties in cooperation with the Olympic Centre Magdeburg / Halle and the Institute for Sports Sciences and Sports Medicine at the University Potsdam.

Michael started to work in Motor Sport as trackside physician at Motorsport Arena Oschersleben, the local circuit, in 1996. Since this time, he has worked across a number of motor racing championships, including FIA Kart Championship, FIA Sportscar, DTM, Porsche Cup, Superbike World Championship, Endurance – 24 Hours – World Championship, FIA GT / WTCC / F1.

Michael received his medical education at Magdeburg University's Faculty of Medicine. His specializations included orthopedics, anesthesia, emergency and sports medicine. After more than 10 years of working at the University Hospital of Magdeburg, he has been appointed senior physician at German Competence Centre for Cartilage – and Bonecell – Transplantation Vogelsang.

During the Sport Conference, Michael will conduct a medical demonstration involving the DMSB's medical team and presenting a realistic accident scenario.
