The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

No / Driver 10 - Jak Crawford

Competitor Hitech Grand Prix

Time 18:25

Session Race 2

Fact Car 28 allegedly forced of Car 10 at Turn 1.

Offence Alleged breach of App. L Chapt. IV art 2(b) of 2021 FIA International Sporting Code.

Decision No further action.

Reason The Stewards having examined video evidence, summoned and heard the drivers and team representatives (Document 65 and 66).

Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards determined that Car 28 overtook Car 10 at the inside line of Turn 1. At the apex of Turn 1 Car 28 was substantially in front of Car 10 and entitled to use the full width of the track. Car 28 completed the pass and stayed fully on track. Car 10 gave up his position and left the track without being forced. The Stewards decided that the driver of car 28 was entitled to use the full track and did not force car 10 off the track.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 10.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
