The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

Competitor Hitech Grand Prix

Session Race 1

Fact Car 10 made contact with Car 23 at turn 1. Both cars retired.

Offence Breach of the FIA Formula 3 Sporting Regulations and of Appendix L, Chapter IV,

Article 2 (d) of the FIA International Sporting Code.

Decision A 5 place grid drop for the next race in which the driver participates. In addition, 3

penalty points to be added to the driver's record - total points for 2021 season = 6

points.

Reason The Stewards examined video evidence. They summoned and heard the drivers and

team representative (document #46 & #47).

Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards determined that Car 10 arrived at Turn 1 and tried a late move into a closing gap. The driver of car 10 locked the front wheels losing control momentarily and crashed into car 23. The Stewards determined that the driver of Car 10 was wholly responsible for the collision.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 10.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time

limits.
