- 1) Front and rear wing width and height.
- 2) Under floor height.
- 3) Rear diffuser height.
- 4) Wheel camber conformity.

The skid planks were checked for thickness and nomination on car numbers 1, 7 and 17.

The clutch was checked for conformity on car numbers 1, 7 and 17.

The driveshaft was checked for conformity on car numbers 1, 7 and 17.

The engine ECU was checked for conformity on car numbers 1, 4, 7, 11, 17 and 18.

The gearbox gear ratios were checked for conformity on car numbers 1, 4, 7, 11, 17 and 18.

The tyre pressures were checked for conformity on car numbers 1, 4, 7, 11, 17 and 18.

All cars had their tyre codes recorded and were checked for the correct allocation.

All the above items and car weights were found to be in conformity with the requirements of the 2021 Formula 3 Championship Regulations.
