The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

**No / Driver** 17 - Victor Martins

**Competitor** MP Motorsport

**Time** 11:27

**Session** Race 3

**Fact** Car 2 made contact with Car 17 and Car 5 on the approach to turn 3 at 11:27.

**Offence** Alleged breach of Chapter IV, Art. 2 (d) of Appendix L to the FIA International Sporting Code.

**Decision** No further action.

**Reason** The Stewards examined video evidence. They summoned and heard the driver of Car 17 and the team representatives of Cars 2 and 17 (documents 85 and 86). The driver of Car 2 was summoned but could not attend the hearing because of a medical issue.

Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards determine that Car 2 tried to make a move on the inside on Car 17 between turns 3 and 4. Car 17 defended his line, but the driver of Car 2 tried to pull alongside regardless. By doing this, he lost control and hit the back of Car 17, damaging his front wing. Subsequently, the Car made contact with Car 5 as the driver was not able to control the damaged car anymore. The Stewards determine that driver of car 2 is wholly at fault.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 10.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
