Technical Delegate's Report

The following driver will start the nineteenth Event of the 2021 Formula One World Championship with a new internal combustion engine (ICE):

44	Mercedes	Lewis Hamilton	4

The internal combustion engine used by Lewis Hamilton is the fifth of the three new internal combustion engines allowed for the 2021 Championship season and this is **not** in conformity with Article 23.2a of the 2021 Formula One Sporting Regulations.

The following driver will start the nineteenth Event of the 2021 Formula One World Championship with a new exhaust system (EX):

16	Ferrari	Charles Leclerc	6
