The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

**No / Driver** 6 - David Schumacher

**Competitor** Trident

**Time** 14:16

**Session** Qualifying

**Fact** Alleged unnecessarily slowing at 14:16 between Turns 11 and 14.

**Offence** Alleged breach of Article 27.4 of the 2021 FIA F3 Championship Sporting Regulations.

**Decision** No further action.

**Reason** The Stewards examined video and telemetry evidence. They summoned and heard the driver and team representative (Document # 22).  
Towards the end of the Qualifying session car 06 was at the lead of a group starting a push lap. From the video it appeared that car 06 slowed unnecessarily although there was a gap of 5 seconds ahead of him. The driver and team manager explained that they did nothing different than on previous preparation laps and that they could not account for what happened with the cars that were following behind. They claimed to have kept a consistent gap to the car behind them and started the lap as normal. The data from the timing system supported the driver's position.  
Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 10.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
