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The Stewards, having received a report from the Technical Delegate (document 36), have considered the following matter and determine the following:

**No / Driver** 6 - Nicholas Latifi

**Competitor** Williams Racing

**Time** 12:15

**Session** Qualifying

**Fact** The front wing/nose assembly has been changed.

**Offence** Breach of Article 34.8 of the FIA Formula One Sporting Regulations.

**Decision** Required to start the race from the pit lane.

**Reason** The changed front wing/nose assembly is of a different specification from the one used during qualifying. The part was replaced with the approval of the FIA Technical Delegate as per article 34.2.

As the front wing/nose assembly is a different specification and was changed whilst the car was in parc ferme, the competitor is required to start the race from the pit lane per article 34.8 b) of the FIA Formula One Sporting Regulations.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 10.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
