The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

**No / Driver** 5 - Liam Lawson

**Competitor** Carlin

**Time** 11:56

**Session** Qualifying

**Fact** Car 11 had stopped on track, shortly before the Control Line, single yellow flags were waved. Car 5 failed to reduce speed in the yellow flag zone and set the overall fastest lap time (1.21.229).

**Offence** Breach of Appendix H, Article 2.5.5 (b) of the FIA International Sporting Code.

**Decision** A drop of 5 places on the grid for the next race in which the driver participates. In addition, 2 points to be added to the driver's record. Total for the 2022 season = 2 points.

In addition, the lap time set under yellow flag conditions - 1:21.229 - has been cancelled as authorised by the FIA International Sporting Code Article 12.4.1.e.

**Reason** The Stewards examined video and timing evidence. They summoned and heard the driver and team representative (document 19).

Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards determined that the Driver did not noticeably reduce his speed in the sector where the yellow flag was displayed for the stranded Car 11. His mini sector time was only 0.012s slower than his best time of that mini sector. During the hearing, the Driver furthermore admitted that he saw the yellow flags and the yellow light panel at Marshal Post 20A. As it was not evident that the driver had reduced speed, the Stewards impose the above penalty.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
