All the above cars were checked for:

- 1) Front and rear wing width and height.
- 2) Under floor height.
- 3) Rear diffuser height.
- 4) Wheel camber conformity.
- 5) Rear wing gurney conformity.

The skid planks were checked for thickness and nomination on car numbers 2, 12 and 29.

The differential was checked for conformity on car numbers 2, 12 and 29.

The engine ECU was checked for conformity on car numbers 2, 8, 12, 18, 20 and 29.

The gearbox gear ratios were checked for conformity on car numbers 2, 8, 12, 18, 20 and 29.

The tyre pressures were checked for conformity on car numbers 2, 8, 12, 18, 20 and 29.

All cars had their tyre codes recorded and were checked for the correct allocation.

All driver weights have been recorded.

Fuel samples were taken from car numbers 2 and 29.

The fuel sample were checked for density and analysed by gas chromatography.

The result of the fuel analysis shows that the fuel was the same as the one, which has been supplied by the official supplier at the event.

All the above items and car weights were found to be in conformity with the requirements of the 2022 Formula 3 Championship Regulations.
