All the above cars were checked for:

- 1) Front and rear wing width and height.
- 2) Under floor height.
- 3) Rear diffuser height.
- 4) Wheel camber conformity.
- 5) Rear wing gurney conformity.

The skid planks were checked for thickness and nomination on car numbers 3, 5 and 7. The left side front and rear brake ducts were checked for conformity on car numbers 3, 5 and 7. The engine ECU was checked for conformity on car numbers 3, 5, 7, 18, 21 and 29. The gearbox gear ratios were checked for conformity on car numbers 3, 5, 7, 18, 21 and 29. The tyre pressures were checked for conformity on car numbers 3, 5, 7, 18, 21 and 29. All cars had their tyre codes recorded and were checked for the correct allocation. All driver weights have been recorded.

All the above items and car weights were found to be in conformity with the requirements of the 2022 Formula 3 Championship Regulations.
