The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

**No / Driver** 16 - Roy Nissany

**Competitor** DAMS

**Time** 09:49

**Session** Race 2

**Fact** Car 16 went off track at Turn 8 and gained a lasting advantage.

**Offence** Breach of Article 27.3 of the FIA Formula 2 Sporting Regulations.

**Decision** Five seconds (5) time penalty in accordance with Article 39.3 (a) of the FIA F2 Sporting Regulations. In addition, 1 penalty point is to be added to the driver's record. Total for the 2022 season = 9 points.

**Reason** The Stewards examined video evidence. Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards determined that Car 16 left the track at Turn 8 to avoid Car 4's (Marino Sato) spin. He rejoined at Turn 9 having passed Car 12 (Clement Novalak) and Car 21 (Calan Williams) while off track, thereby gaining a lasting advantage, which was not subsequently given back.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
