The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

Session Race 2

Fact Car 6 was released from his mandatory pit stop when Car 16 (Roy Nissany) was already in the fast lane.

Offence Breach of Article 28.11 (a) of the FIA Formula 2 Sporting Regulations.

Decision No further action.

Reason The Stewards examined video evidence. They summoned and heard the drivers and team representatives (documents 44 & 45).

The Stewards determined that Car 6 was released into a very tight window in front of Car 16. However on cold tyres and having not had an opportunity to scrub in the set of tyres, the Driver of Car 6 experienced a slightly slower than normal getaway because of wheelspin and rather than coming out in front of Car 16, Car 6 had to avoid Car 16 and filter in behind him. Car 16 reported that it was clear that Car 6 had seen him coming and took the appropriate action to avoid a collision. The drivers managed the situation very well and while it was very close it was determined that the regulations were not breached.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
