Technical Delegate's Report

During and after the free practice session:

All cars had their tyre codes recorded and were checked for the correct allocation.

After the qualifying session:

The following cars were weighed

All the above cars were checked for:

- 1) Front and rear wing width and height.
- 2) Under floor height.
- 3) Rear diffuser height.
- 4) Wheel camber conformity.
- 5) Rear wing gurney conformity.

The skid planks were checked for thickness and nomination on car numbers **5**, **8** and **16**. The brake ducts, pads, calipers and discs front and rear right were checked for conformity on car numbers **5**, **8** and **16**.

The engine ECU was checked for conformity on car numbers **3**, **5**, **8**, **10**, **16** and **17**. The gearbox gear ratios were checked for conformity on car numbers **3**, **5**, **8**, **10**, **16** and **17**.

The tyre pressures were checked for conformity on car numbers **3**, **5**, **8**, **10**, **16** and **17**. All cars had their tyre codes recorded and were checked for the correct allocation. All driver weights have been recorded.
