BULLETIN 3 – Amendment to FIA F3 Sporting Regulation Article 33.3

The following changes have been made to the F3 Sporting Regulations with immediate effect in accordance to Article 1.3 of the FIA F3 Sporting Regulations.

- 35.2 An alternative Sprint race grid may be arranged in Monaco. The overall fastest driver from both groups will start the race from 12th position. The 11th place on the grid will be awarded to the driver who has achieved the fastest time in the other group and 10th place will be awarded to the driver who has achieved the second fastest time in the group of the overall fastest driver, and so on.

By way of illustration:

The Qualifying Group that contains the fastest qualifying car overall shall be the “Pole Group”. The other group shall be the “Second Group”.

6 th fastest car from Pole Group	2 nd
5 th fastest car from Second Group	3 rd
5 th fastest car from Pole Group	4 th

3 rd fastest car from Second Group	7 th
3 rd fastest car from Pole Group	8 th
2 nd fastest car from Second Group	9 th

7 th fastest car from Second Pole Group	13 th
7 th fastest car from Pole Second Group	14 th and so on
