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The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

**No / Driver** 10 - Franco Colapinto

**Competitor** MP Motorsport

**Time** 13:46

**Session** Practice

**Fact** Car 7 (Frederick) collided with Car 10 (Colapinto) at T10

**Infringement** Alleged breach of Appendix L, Chapter IV article 2 (d) of the FIA International Sporting Code

**Decision** No further action

**Reason** The Stewards examined video evidence. They summoned and heard the drivers and team representatives (documents 11 & 12). During the hearing the driver of Car 7 stated that both cars were on a fast lap, but he was a bit quicker than Car 10. Approaching Turn 10 Car 7 was behind Car 10, with a reasonable gap between them. The driver of Car 7 admitted that he was not expecting that the gap would close so quickly at the apex of the corner, which resulted in a minor tap with the rear of Car 10. The driver of Car 10 explained that because of the wet track he was a bit slower than usual at Turn 10 and that he did not feel the contact in his rear. Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards determined that although there was a small contact between both cars, neither of the driver was wholly or predominantly to blame for the incident. Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rule, within the applicable time limits.
