The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

No / Driver 10 - Isack Hadjar

Competitor Hitech Pulse-Eight

Time 15:15

Session Qualifying

Fact Car 10 (Hadjar) allegedly impeded Car 4 (Fittipaldi) between T11 and T12 at 15:15 in F2 Qualifying Group A.

Infringement Alleged breach of Article 31.6 of the FIA Formula 2 Sporting Regulations.

Decision No further action.

Reason The Stewards examined video evidence. They summoned and heard the drivers and team representatives (documents 24 & 25).
Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards determined that at the exit of Turn 11, Car 10 was prepping his tyres for a push lap in sync with the cars in front of him, when Car 4, who was on a push lap, caught up with him. Due to marshalling system issues in the pit lane, his team was unable to warn him of Car 4's presence. Car 4 then abandoned his lap. The Stewards consider that this did not rise to the level of unnecessary impeding under the circumstances.
Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
