The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

No / Driver 27 - Taylor Barnard

Competitor Jenzer Motorsport

Session Practice

Fact A Team mechanic for Car 27 crossed the pit exit line onto the circuit during the Session and performed work on Car 27 when it was on the circuit

Offence Breach of Articles 22.6 and 22.7 of the F3 Sporting Regulations - working on the car beyond the pit lane exit.

Decision A fine of 1,000 EUROS to be paid by the Competitor. In accordance with Article 12.8.1 of the ISC, fines shall be paid within forty-eight hours of their notification by means of bank transfer to the FIA.

Reason The Stewards examined video evidence. They summoned and heard from the team representative (document 15). Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards determined that during the Session Car 27 was stopped in the pit exit lane beyond the end of the pit lane. The driver had switched the engine off after an attempted practice start and could not restart it. A Team mechanic walked towards the car carrying a battery jump-pack, crossed over the pit lane end-line and approached Car 27. The mechanic attached the jump-pack to start Car 27 and walked back into the pit lane.

Article 22.7 of the 2023 FIA Formula 3 Sporting Regulations prohibits team personnel from entering the track or the pit exit during any practice session other than in limited circumstances, none of which apply. Article 22.6 of the 2023 FIA Formula 3 Sporting Regulations prohibits repairs being carried out to a car anywhere other than in the paddock, the pits and the grid. The Stewards are satisfied that in this case the mechanic breached both such Articles.
