The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

No / Driver 1 - Dennis Hauger

Competitor MP Motorsport

Time 13:54

Session Race 1

Fact Car 1 (Hauger) was alleged to have forced Car 9 (Crawford) off track at T3/T4 in Race 1 at 13:54.

Infringement Alleged breach of Appendix L Chapter IV, Article 2 (b) of the FIA International Sporting Code.

Decision No further action.

Reason The Stewards examined video evidence. They summoned and heard the drivers and team representatives (documents 32 & 33).

Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards determined that Car 1 was overtaking Car 9 on the inside of Turn 3. Video evidence showed that Car 1 had his front axle in front of Car 9 at the apex of the corner and that he drove in a controlled manner throughout the manoeuvre. At the exit of the corner Car 1 ran wide, but remained within the track limits, while Car 9 left the track.

The Stewards determined that Car 1 had the right to the line at Turn 3 and did not deliberately force Car 9 off the track at the exit of the corner. Therefore, we decided that no further action was needed.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
