The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

**No / Driver** 28 - Alejandro Garcia

**Competitor** Jenzer Motorsport

**Time** 09:59

**Session** Race 1

**Fact** Car 28 (Garcia)

**Infringement** Alleged breach of Article 40.7 of the FIA Formula 3 Sporting Regulations.

**Decision** No further action

**Reason** The Stewards examined video evidence. They summoned and heard the driver and team representative (document 26). Car 28 was on slick tyres with mixed conditions on track. Specifically Turns 7 to 14 were quite wet. On the lap when the Safety Car period ended, Car 28 was ahead of a small group of cars and approximately 10 seconds behind the main group. In normal conditions we would have expected Car 28 to make every effort to catch the pack and close the gap. He did not appear to do so and when the lead car re-started there was still a 7 second gap between the back of the pack and Car 28. The driver explained that due to the length of the safety car period and the fact that earlier in the lap the cars ahead of him slowed significantly he lost all temperature in his tyres and he was unable to drive faster in the conditions to catch the pack ahead.

Having considered the matter extensively and reviewed the video it was clear that the driver of car 28 made all reasonable efforts to catch the pack and as such the Stewards take no further action.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
