The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

**No / Driver** 2 - Jehan Daruvala

**Competitor** MP Motorsport

**Time** 14:31

**Session** Race 1

**Fact** The head rest of Car 2 (Daruvala) came loose during Race 1.

**Infringement** Breach of Article 3.2 of the FIA Formula 2 Sporting Regulations.

**Decision** No further action.

**Reason** The Stewards examined video evidence and the physical evidence of the head rest. They summoned and heard the driver and team representative (document 36) and the Technical Delegate.

Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards determined that the Stewards determined that the headrest of Car 2 came loose and fell off the car during Race 1. Immediately after that incident, Car 2 entered the pit lane and retired from Race 1.

During the hearing, the Technical Delegate explained that the damage on the remains of the head rest show that the left front pin broke, and the broken pin caused the head rest to come loose and fall off from the car. Therefore the Stewards take no action on account of a part failure. The Stewards commend the Driver for promptly retiring the car.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
