The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

**No / Driver** 24 - Kush Maini

**Competitor** Campos Racing

**Time** 10:57

**Session** Practice

**Fact** Car 24 (Maini) pulled around and then in front of other stationary cars before performing his practice start.

**Infringement** Alleged breach of Article 12.2.1.h of the FIA International Sporting Code.

**Decision** No further action.

**Reason** The Stewards examined video evidence. They summoned and heard the driver and team representative (document 18).

Car 24 saw that the two cars at the rear of the grid had stalled and the lights were flashing on their rear wing to show this. Car 24 could see this and moved around, and then directly in front of them in the same grid column before performing his practice start. Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards determined that Car 24 had the opportunity to carry out his practice start on the right side of the grid where there would have been no cars behind him. This would have been a better option. Nevertheless, the Stewards accept that the cars which were passed had in fact stalled. That being the case, Car 24 pulling in front of them did not constitute a dangerous act. The Stewards therefore decided no further action.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
