The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

**No / Driver** 7 - Kaylen Frederick

**Competitor** ART Grand Prix

**Time** 09:18

**Session** Race 2

**Fact** Car 7 collided into Car 9 at Turn 3 during a safety car period

**Offence** Breach of Appendix L Chapter IV, Article 2 (e) of the FIA International Sporting Code – driving car erratically

**Decision** A drop of 10 places on the grid for Car 7 for the next race in which the driver participates. In addition, 3 points to be added to the driver's record. Total for the 2023 season = 3 points.

**Reason** The Stewards examined video evidence and reviewed GPS telemetry. They summoned and heard the drivers of Car 7 (Fredrick) and Car 9 (Tsolov) and their team representatives (documents 65 & 66).

Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards determined that Car 7 was accelerating and decelerating to maintain tyre temperatures. Car 9 was ahead. Car 7 had fallen back creating a gap behind Car 9. Car 7 accelerated on the approach to Turn 3 and misjudged the speed differential colliding with the rear of Car 9. Drivers must exercise the needed diligence and caution during safety car periods and must not make erratic manoeuvres that would danger themselves or others.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
