The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

No / Driver 8 - Gregoire Saucy

Competitor ART Grand Prix

Time 11:26

Session Qualifying

Fact Car 8 failed to slow down under single yellow flag at T15

Infringement Breach of Appendix H, Article 2.5.5 b) of the FIA International Sporting Code.

Decision A drop of 3 places on the grid for the next race in which the driver participates. In addition, 2 points to be added to the driver's record. Total for the 2023 season = 2 points.

Reason The Stewards examined the video and data evidence. They summoned and heard the driver and team representative (document 32).

Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards determined that the driver of Car 8 was on a fast lap and driving towards T15 when he saw a single yellow flag being waved and a car which had crashed on the left side of the track. The driver had adequate time to react to the notification and he confirmed he saw the panel and flag. Marshalling segment data showed that the driver set a time that was faster than his previous session times and consequently he drove his fastest lap time of the session. This does not reflect a significant reduction in speed as required by the regulations.

Video evidence showed that a marshal waved a green flag just after the crashed car, which made the yellow area much smaller than the marshalling sector.

The Stewards took into consideration that fact, and therefore decided to impose a drop of 3 grid places plus 2 penalty points.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
