



1	Floor Body	Performance - Local Load	Adding volume to the rear floor body	The updated floor geometry is aiming to improve the flow characteristics by reducing the losses in critical ride height conditions.
2	Rear Corner	Performance - Local Load	Repositioned rear brake duct lower deflector	The repositioned rear brake duct lower deflector is aiming to improve the rear tyre jet vortex control and increasing the overall efficiency of the diffuser.
