The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

Competitor Trident Motorsport

Session Race 2

Fact Car 6 (Ramos) allegedly gained a lasting advantage at Turn 1.

Infringement Alleged breach of Appendix L, Chapter IV, Article 2 c) of the FIA International Sporting Code.

Decision No further action

Reason The Stewards reviewed video evidence.

On Lap 12 of the Race, Car 6 (Bedrin), left the track at the exit of Turn 1, went through the escape road and rejoined after Turn 2. An analysis of the GPS Track Map showed that Car 6 did not gain any positions as a result of leaving the track and rejoining. Car 9 (Dunne) had been behind Car 6 at the entry to Turn 1 and Car 6 lost a position to Car 9 after Car 6 re-joined.

Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards determined that no lasting advantage was gained by Car 6 as a result of leaving the track.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
