The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

No / Driver 23 - Roman Stanek

Competitor Trident Motorsport

Time 15:51

Session Qualifying

Fact Car 23 (Stanek) was alleged to have impeded Car 11 (Hauger) at Turn 17-18 during Qualifying.

Infringement Breach of Article 31.6 of the FIA Formula 2 Sporting Regulations.

Decision No further action.

Reason The Stewards summoned and heard the drivers and team representatives (documents 18 & 19) and examined video and GPS evidence.

Car 23 (Stanek) was alleged to have impeded Car 11 (Hauger) at Turn 18 and through Turn 19. The cars were off sequence from each other with Car 11 closing on Car 23 as they approached Turn 18. Car 23 explained that he saw Car 11 coming and elected start his push lap earlier than normal to avoid impeding. The cars got close to each in the braking zone at Turn 18 but Car 11 remained approximately 11 meters behind at their closest point before both pushed to complete the lap speedily. The Stewards accept that Car 11 might have been visually affected by Car 23 after having rapidly closed on him; however, the Stewards determine that it cannot be said that Car 23 unnecessarily impeded Car 11. Accordingly, the Stewards elect to take no further action.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
