The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

No / Driver 22 - Richard Verschoor

Competitor Trident Motorsport

Time 10:27

Session Race 2

Fact Car 22 (Verschoor) removed his steering wheel while still in motion in the pit lane, on the final approach to his pit box.

Infringement Breach of Article 12.2.1.h of the FIA International Sporting Code.

Decision A fine of 1000 Euros to be paid by the Driver. In accordance with Article 12.8.1 of the ISC, fines shall be paid within forty-eight hours of their notification by means of bank transfer to the FIA.

Reason The Stewards examined video evidence. They summoned and heard the driver and team representative (document 61).
The driver explained that he felt quite frustrated as he had been leading the race and then suffered a loss of power which forced him to retire. Therefore, on arrival at the pit stops he threw the steering wheel out of the car while it was still moving. The driver apologized for this lapse. The Stewards determined that this is an unsafe act and therefore the penalty has been applied.
Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
