The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

Competitor DAMS Lucas Oil

Session Qualifying

Fact Car 8 (Correa) unnecessarily impeded Car 4 (Antonelli) at Turn 10 during Qualifying.

Infringement Breach of Article 31.6 of the FIA Formula 2 Sporting Regulations.

Decision A drop of 3 places on the grid for the next race in which the driver participates. No

driver penalty points are associated with this infringement.

Reason The Stewards examined video evidence. They summoned and heard the drivers and

team representatives (documents 16 &17).

During the hearing the driver of Car 8 stated that he was on a slow lap and was not aware of Car 4 behind being on a fast lap. He added that he didn't get any information from his team. The team representative confirmed that due to the weak GPS signal the data on their map was not on point and they had realized too late that Car 4 was approaching. The Driver of Car 8 apologised to the driver of Car 4 for impeding

Video evidence clearly showed that Car 4 had to slow down at Turn 10, when he caught Car 8. Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards determined that Car 8 unnecessarily impeded Car 4 and therefore decided to impose a drop of 3 grid places for the next race in which he participates.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
