The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, summoned (document 8) and heard from the team representative, have considered the following matter and hereby determine the following:

Session Practice 2

Fact Car 9 was released from a pit stop in an unsafe condition.

Offence Breach of Article 28.13 (b) of the FIA Formula One Sporting Regulations.

Decision The competitor (Alfa Romeo Sauber F1 Team) is fined €5,000.

Reason The Stewards reviewed the video of the pit stop of Car 9 at 16:07 and heard from the team representative.

The Stewards determined that the car was released in an unsafe condition in breach of Art. 28.13(b) as the wheel was not properly attached to the car when released.

The team reacted instantly, instructing the driver to stop the car and the driver stopped the car in a safe manner immediately.

Consistent with previous decisions of a similar nature, the Stewards decided that the grid place penalty mentioned in the above Article would not be applied as the driver took all appropriate actions at the first available opportunity. Accordingly, the Stewards fined the team €5,000.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal the decisions of the Stewards (with the exception of those referred to in Article 12.2.4 of the FIA International Sporting Code), in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 9.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
