The skid planks were checked for conformity, nomination and thickness on car numbers **3**, **5**, and **15**. The engine ECU mapping was checked for conformity on car numbers **3**, **5**, **7**, **11**, **15** and **18**. The gearbox gear ratios were checked for conformity on car numbers **3**, **5**, **7**, **11**, **15** and **18**. The tyre pressures were checked for conformity on the second set of tyres used on car numbers **3**, **5**, **7**, **11**,

15 and 18.

The front and rear ARB and blade were checked for conformity on car numbers **3**, **8**, and **20**. All cars had their tyre codes recorded.

Fuel samples were taken from car number 3 and 5.

The fuel samples were checked for density and analyzed by gas chromatography. The result of the fuel analyses shows that the fuel was the same as the one, which has been supplied by the official supplier at the event.

All the above items and car weights were found to be in conformity with the requirements of the 2020 Formula 3 Championship Technical Regulations.
