All the above cars were checked for:

- 1) Front and rear wing width and height.
- 2) Under floor height.
- 3) Rear diffuser height.
- 4) Wheel camber conformity.

The skid planks were checked for thickness and nomination on car numbers 1, 7 and 18.

The rear wing assembly was checked for conformity on car numbers 1, 7 and 18.

The engine ECU was checked for conformity on car numbers 1, 5, 7, 8, 10 and 18.

The gearbox gear ratios were checked for conformity on car numbers 1, 5, 7, 8, 10 and 18.

The tyre pressures were checked for conformity on the first set of tyres used on car numbers 7 and 10.

The tyre pressures were checked for conformity on the second set of tyres used on car numbers 1, 5, 7, 8, 10 and 18.

All cars had their tyre codes recorded and were checked for the correct allocation.

All driver weights have been recorded.

Fuel samples were taken from car numbers 7 and 18.

The fuel samples were checked for density and analysed by gas chromatography.

The result of the fuel analysis shows that the fuel was the same as the one, which has been supplied by the official supplier at the event.

All the above items and car weights were found to be in conformity with the requirements of the 2021 Formula 3 Championship Regulations.
