The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, summoned (documents 22 & 23) and heard the driver and team representatives, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

Competitor Haas F1 Team

Time 15:39

Session Qualifying

Fact Incident between cars 14 and 20 in Turn 1.

Offence Alleged Breach of Article 31.5 of the FIA Formula One Sporting Regulations.

Decision No further action.

Reason The Stewards reviewed video, positioning data and telemetry evidence, heard from the driver of car 14 (Fernando Alonso), the driver of car 20 (Kevin Magnussen) and the team representatives.

The Stewards determined that the incident between Car 14 and Car 20 at turn one did not specifically constitute unnecessary impeding by either driver, notwithstanding the fact that both drivers lost their lap.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal the decisions of the Stewards (with the exception of those referred to in Article 12.2.4 of the FIA International Sporting Code), in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 9.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
