The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

**No / Driver** 16 - Roy Nissany

**Competitor** DAMS

**Time** 17:42

**Session** Race 1

**Fact** Car 16 was driving unnecessarily slowly whilst exiting the pit lane on two reconnaissance laps prior to the start of the Sprint Race.

**Offence** Breach of Article 27.4 of the FIA Formula 2 Sporting Regulations.

**Decision** Reprimand.

**Reason** The Stewards examined video evidence. They summoned and heard the driver and team representative (document 26).

The driver stated that he was trying to change brake bias while proceeding slowly through the pit lane as this cannot be done whilst the car is stationary. The Stewards advised that the pit exit and/or the pit lane is not the right place to drive extremely slowly as all other cars will be impeded on their reconnaissance laps. The driver admitted his mistake.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
