The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

**No / Driver** 05 – Sergio Sette Camara  
**Competitor** DAMS  
**Time** 10:13  
**Session** Race 1  
**Fact** Car 12 was in 11<sup>th</sup> position on the grid, Car 05 was in 12<sup>th</sup> position on the grid. Car 05 was ahead of Car 12 at the Safety Car Line 1 and did not start from the pit lane.  
**Offence** Breach of Article 36.8 of the 2019 FIA F2 Championship Sporting regulations.  
**Decision** Written reprimand  
**Reason** The Stewards examined data evidence. They summoned and heard the drivers and team representatives (documents 28 & 29). Having considered the matter extensively, and heard the testimony from both drivers, it is clear that the drivers of both Car 05 and Car 12 knew that they were out of position after the start of the formation lap, due to the relative speeds of their launches. While the primary responsibility for regaining the proper position in this case lies with Car 05, who passed Car 12 to create the out of position status, Car 12 also bore responsibility to re-establish the correct start order. Therefore, both drivers are being penalised for their lack of aggressive reaction to cancel the problem. It must be noted that the penalty in Article 36.8 was specified for a totally different start scenario and, therefore, is not appropriate in this case.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 9.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
