The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

Session Race 1

Fact Car 20 was released in an unsafe manner – the left rear wheel nut was not attached correctly. The car departed but was stopped and pushed back up the pit lane to the race team, where they refitted the left rear wheel nut correctly & released the car.

Offence Breach of Article 28.12 (c) of the 2019 FIA F2 Championship Sporting regulations.

Decision As the Driver finished Race 1 and was classified, a total of 30 seconds are to be added to the total race time – being a 10 second stop & go penalty with an additional 20 seconds as per Article 38.3 (d)

Reason The Stewards examined video evidence. They summoned and heard the driver and team representative (document 22). Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards determined that Car 20 was released in an unsafe manner and the Team Manager acknowledged this fact and apologised to the Driver and the Stewards.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 9.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
