The skid planks were checked for conformity, nomination and thickness on car numbers 7, 10, and 22.

The engine ECU was checked for conformity on car numbers 2, 5, 7, 8, 10 and 22.

The gearbox gear ratios were checked for conformity on car numbers 2, 5, 7, 8, 10 and 22.

The tyre pressures were checked for conformity on car numbers 2, 5, 7, 8, 10 and 22.

The anti-roll bar rear, the anti-roll bar blade front, the anti-roll bar front, the anti-roll bar blade rear, the rocker rear, the bearing, the bearing rail rear, the front RHS rocker cplt, the bearing rail front and the bearing thrust were checked for conformity on car numbers **7**, **10** and **22**.

All cars had their tyre codes recorded.

A fuel sample was taken from car number 7.

The fuel samples were checked for density and analyzed by gas chromatography.

The result of the fuel analyses shows that the fuel was the same as the one, which has been supplied by the official supplier at the event.

All the above items and car weights were found to be in conformity with the requirements of the 2020 Formula 3 Championship Technical Regulations.
