The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

No / Driver 20 – Leonardo Pulcini
Competitor Hitech Grand Prix
Time Between 18:16 & 18:20
Session Qualifying
Fact Car 20 drove unnecessarily slowly on track during the Qualifying Session
Offence Breach of Article 27.4 of the 2019 FIA F3 Championship Sporting regulations.
Decision A drop of 5 grid positions for the next race in which the driver participates.
Reason The Stewards examined video evidence. They summoned and heard the driver and team representative (Document 33). Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards determined that the driver of the car could have driven in a different manner which would have alleviated or avoided the issue of cars building up behind him on track. Because of the unique nature of this infringement, the Stewards made a conscious decision not to assign the penalty points normally associated with this infringement.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 9.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
