The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

Session Race 3

**Fact** Car 7 stopped near the pit lane exit as a result of mechanical issues.

Offence Alleged breach of Article 39.3 of the FIA Formula 2 Sporting Regulations

**Decision** No further action.

**Reason** The Stewards examined video evidence. They summoned and heard the driver and

team representative (document 63)

The Driver advised that the fire extinguisher went off and that all systems on the car shut down. Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards agreed that the foam made it impossible to see through the visor of the helmet. The driver was unable to direct the car as he was unable to see where he was going, so he gradually slowed to a stop. The fact that the fire extinguisher deployed was confirmed by the Technical Delegate after a visual inspection of the car. Based on these facts, the Stewards take no further action.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 9.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
