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The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

<b>No / Driver</b>	24 – Alessio Deledda
<b>Competitor</b>	Campos Racing
<b>Time</b>	10:41
<b>Session</b>	Race 1
<b>Fact</b>	Car 24 was alleged to have committed a potentially dangerous manoeuvre at Turn 1
<b>Offence</b>	Breach of Article 27.4 of the 2019 FIA F3 Championship Sporting regulations.
<b>Decision</b>	No further action
<b>Reason</b>	The Stewards examined video evidence. They summoned and heard the driver and team representatives (document 66). Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards determined that Car 24 had a brake issue which caught him out at the entrance to Turn 1. He arrived there far too fast and took to the escape road. Fortunately, there was a hole in traffic and he was able to make the manoeuvre without contacting other cars, although there were two near misses.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 9.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
